## RESOLUTION APPROVING NAMING OF 14<sup>TH</sup> STREET RECREATION CENTER IN HONOR OF MRS. MINNIE LEE DAVIS HARRIS

**WHEREAS**, The Recreation and Parks Commission, at its February 4, 2020 meeting received a request from Council Member Annette Scippio, East Ward to rename the 14<sup>th</sup> Street Recreation Center after Mrs. Minnie Lee Davis Harris; and

**WHEREAS,** Mrs. Minnie Lee Davis Harris began working for the Winston-Salem Recreation and Parks Department in 1948; and

WHEREAS, in 1950 Mrs. Harris became the first African American female Recreation Center Director in the Department; and

**WHEREAS,** she worked at Skyland Recreation Center for 20 years before transferring to the new 14<sup>th</sup> Street Recreation Center built in 1967; and

WHEREAS, she continued to work at 14<sup>th</sup> Street until she retired in 1971; and

**WHEREAS,** throughout the years, Mrs. Harris instilled quality values and expectations in the lives of thousands of children and adults she worked with; and

**WHEREAS,** the Recreation and Parks Commission supported the renaming of the 14<sup>th</sup> Street Recreation Center to the Minnie Lee Davis Harris Recreation Center.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor, Mayor Pro Tempore and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that the 14<sup>th</sup> Street Recreation Center be renamed the Minnie Lee Davis Harris Recreation Center.
