RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE OLD GREENSBORO ROAD BRIDGE OVER BRUSHY FORK CREEK

WHEREAS, the Bridge Formula Program (BFP) is a program that provides funding to the states through the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) to replace, rehabilitate, preserve, protect, and construct highway bridges; and

WHEREAS, the program funding can be used on bridges located on or off the Federalaid system; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) and City of Winston-Salem have identified Bridge 330330 over Brushy Fork Creek as an off-system bridge owned by a county, town, township, city, municipality, or other local agency eligible for 100 percent Federal reimbursement through the Bridge Formula Program; and

WHEREAS, this project was selected as a complete bridge replacement with construction programmed for 2028; and

WHEREAS, the NCDOT Agreement would authorize funds for preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition, and construction related services for the replacement of the bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Bridge Program formula funds will reimburse the City of Winston-Salem up to \$4,815,000.00 for eligible project expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Winston-Salem Department of Transportation recommends execution of the grant agreement with NCDOT to begin pre-construction, environmental assessment, and design activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that the City Council authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with NCDOT for the Replacement of the Old Greensboro Road Bridge over Brushy Fork Creek.
