

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTH CAROLINA  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE OLD  
GREENSBORO ROAD BRIDGE OVER BRUSHY FORK CREEK**

**WHEREAS**, the Bridge Formula Program (BFP) is a program that provides funding to the states through the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) to replace, rehabilitate, preserve, protect, and construct highway bridges; and

**WHEREAS**, the program funding can be used on bridges located on or off the Federal-aid system; and

**WHEREAS**, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) and City of Winston-Salem have identified Bridge 330330 over Brushy Fork Creek as an off-system bridge owned by a county, town, township, city, municipality, or other local agency eligible for 100 percent Federal reimbursement through the Bridge Formula Program; and

**WHEREAS**, this project was selected as a complete bridge replacement with construction programmed for 2028; and

**WHEREAS**, the NCDOT Agreement would authorize funds for preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition, and construction related services for the replacement of the bridge; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Bridge Program formula funds will reimburse the City of Winston-Salem up to \$4,815,000.00 for eligible project expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, the Winston-Salem Department of Transportation recommends execution of the grant agreement with NCDOT to begin pre-construction, environmental assessment, and design activities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that the City Council authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with NCDOT for the Replacement of the Old Greensboro Road Bridge over Brushy Fork Creek.
