**RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER FOR
VEHICLE LIGHTING & INTERNAL EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, after due advertisement, a bid was received and publicly opened by the City/County Purchasing Department at 10:00 a.m., Monday, August 16, 2021, for vehicle lighting & internal equipment used to upfit the 2022 Ford Interceptor police pursuit vehicles for the Winston-Salem Police Department. The following bid was received:

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a purchase order be awarded to Batteries of NC, LLC, the only vendor to submit a bid for the vehicle lighting & internal equipment in the estimated amount of \$478,560.45.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem that a purchase order for vehicle lighting & internal equipment used to upfit the 2022 Ford Interceptor police pursuit vehicles is hereby awarded to Batteries of NC, LLC, in the estimated amount of \$478,560.45.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this purchase order constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the contract until the contract is duly executed by the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the purchase is included in the FY 2021-22 capital budget and will be financed through the North Carolina Municipal Leasing Corporation with funding for the lease payments available in the FY 2021-22 General Fund budget.
