Information was gathered from various North Carolina cities who created dedicated and restricted funds to addres their affordable housing needs. On September 25, 2023, during a Special Committee Meeting of the Whole, Staff reviewed information from benchmark cities to identify strategies and process for creating a housing trust fund. The Mayor received verbal commitments to seed a potential housing trust fund. On October 9, 2023, Council approved the resolution establishing the need to create a dedicated and restricted fund for affordable housing and directed staff to further pursue creating recommendations for its administration and management. **Committee Action:** Committee CD/H/GG- 04/08/24 Action Approval For Unanimous **Against Remarks:**

On March 18, 2024, during a Special Committee Meeting of the Whole, Staff recommended the Winston-Salem Foundation to lead the charge by engaging the community to develop the fund. Further, staff recommended continuing the City's Affordable Houisng Initiative by providing gap financing and bridge loans for affordable rental, preservation, and homeownership projects. The attached resolution establishes support for Staff's recommendations for the Housing Trust Fund and separately, the City's continued support of affordable projects through gap financing and bridge loans for affordable rental, preservation, and homeownership projects.
