Summary of Information:

Bids were received May 22, 2019, for the purchase of quarry products as needed by city departments for a contract period from date of award through June 30, 2020, with the option to extend the contract for as many as four additional twelve-month periods, subject to agreement by both parties and funds being available for this purpose. All stone must comply with North Carolina Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures dated January 2018 for sizes and grades as shown on Attachment A. The summary of bids received are listed below:

It is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Vulcan Construction Material, LP, the low bidder meeting specifications for quarry products as needed by city departments in the estimated annual amount of \$483,010.30 for a contract period from date of award through June 30, 2020, with the option to extend the contract for as many as four additional twelve-month periods, subject to agreement by both parties and funds being available for this purpose. Should the contract be extended beyond the initial period, terms of the bid allow the contract price to be adjusted by an amount not to exceed the most recent Producer Price Index.
