and University in the nation to grant degrees for teaching the elementary grades and has a longstanding tradition for producing talented graduates in

the fields of Nursing and Health Sciences; and

WHEREAS: Winston-Salem native Bonita J. Brown was officially elected by the

University of North Carolina Board of Governors and appointed as the 14<sup>th</sup> Chancellor and first female leader of Winston-Salem State University,

effective July 1st of this year; and

WHEREAS: Winston-Salem State University has produced over 30,000 alumni who

embody the spirit of the university motto "Enter to Learn, Depart to Serve" and who reside in the Triad, across the State of North Carolina and around

the globe; and

WHEREAS: Winston-Salem State University is a Regional Comprehensive University

with an annual economic impact of more than \$500 million on the Piedmont Triad region and serves as a driver for economic and workforce

development for the City of Winston-Salem and beyond; and

WHEREAS: Winston-Salem State University has been recognized by multiple national

media outlets as the #1 university in North Carolina for economic and social

mobility for its students; and

WHEREAS: The City of Winston-Salem recognizes and celebrates the significant

achievements of Winston-Salem State University, and its substantial positive influence on the local community, in the past, presently, and in the

future.
