These trucks are used for brush collection throughout the city year-round and for bulky item collection 26 weeks out of each year. See Exhibit A for replacement information.

On May 21, 2025, the North Carolina Sheriff's Association, a cooperative purchasing group located in Raleigh, North Carolina, awarded contracts for Heavy Equipment whereas Amick Equipment Company, Inc. (Lexington, SC) was awarded competitive bid contract #26-10-0422 per bid specifications. Amick Equipment Company, Inc. has offered a quotation for two Freightliner M2 chassis with Peterson Atlas hoist loader bodies at a cost of \$261,380.04 each with standard options selected by the city, for a total cost of \$522,760.08. See Exhibit B for an example graphic of the equipment being purchased.

N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3) authorizes "purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or more public agencies."

It is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Amick Equipment Company, Inc., per North Carolina Sheriffs Association contract #26-10-0422, for two hoist loader trucks at a cost of \$261,380.04 each for a total cost of \$522,760.08. These recommendations are in accordance with N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3).
