## RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR CITYWIDE PAVEMENT CONDITION SURVEY

**WHEREAS**, Pavement Management is a critical function for maintaining and preserving the City street network; and

**WHEREAS**, being efficient in allocating resources for street repairs and repaving contracts is a necessity, but sometimes difficult due to variables involved; and

**WHEREAS,** performing a Citywide Pavement Condition survey allows for a uniform, unbiased perspective of the street system as a whole and allows allocation of funding to be applied objectively; and

**WHEREAS**, in March of 2024, the City/County Purchasing solicited proposals from various professional engineering firms for the development of a citywide pavement condition survey; and

**WHEREAS**, three proposals were submitted and the selection committee recommends awarding the contract to WithersRavenal.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with WithersRavenal for engineering services for a citywide pavement condition survey with fees not-to-exceed \$814,000. The City is not legally bound to perform the contract until it is duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Powell Bill reserves will provide the necessary funding for this contract.
