Last fall, I returned to finish my degrees at Wake Forest University after having spent the prior two years in the workforce, employed by both for-profit companies (construction, woodworking, stevedoring/shipping, supply chain, etc.) and various nonprofits (humanitarian aid/assistance, early-childhood education, faith-based care, etc.). In March, I was awarded a research scholarship through Wake Forest to study effective affordable housing and homelessness solutions worldwide with the purpose of synthesizing them into discrete, achievable policy recommendations for Winston- Salem's city council. I spent most of May conducting on- location analyses and interviews in Helsinki, Copenhagen, and Vienna, and I have several more meetings scheduled with individuals from each of those cities (government officials,

experts, researchers, city planners, architects, non-profit leaders, etc.) in the coming months. Future expansions to the scope of our research have been planned to include remote analyses of specific policies in Toronto, Canada; Berlin, Germany; and Barcelona, Spain. I have been given the unique privilege to develop relationships with some of the world's foremost scholars on these matters, and I want to use that privilege to help my city however I can. Furthermore, preliminary results of our research suggest that many of the more effective affordable housing solutions directly affect (and simultaneously seek to address) the housing situations of students and refugees; we therefore believe it could be of additional value to consider student-aged and refugee perspectives on the Coalition where possible.

[NOTE: Barring any unforeseeable complications, I will be continuing my work and/or education in Winston-Salem indefinitely post-graduation, so I will be eligible and available to serve the entire duration of a Coalition appointment. I am, however, specifically requesting involvement while still enrolled so that we can fully utilize the vast array of unique resources and connections that I have been afforded as a student.]
