

**RESOLUTION AWARDING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR
MUDDY CREEK GREENWAY REPAIRS PROJECT**

WHEREAS, after proper advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by City/County Purchasing at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 17, 2025, for construction of the Muddy Creek Greenway Repairs project, and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the low bidder, RES Environmental Operating Company, LLC, submitted M/WBE subcontracting goals for this project of 6.05% with minority-owned businesses and 12.14% with women-owned businesses; exceeding the 6% minority-owned businesses goal and 4% woman-owned business goal established for the project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that a contract be awarded to RES Environmental Operating Company, LLC, the low bidder meeting specifications, for construction of the Muddy Creek Greenway Repairs project in the estimated amount of \$827,597.62.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon approval by the Finance Committee, that the contract for the Muddy Creek Greenway Repairs project is hereby awarded to RES Environmental Operating Company, LLC in the estimated amount of \$827,597.62. The City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City, with contract and bond forms to be approved by the City Attorney and bid deposit retained until the successful bidder has provided satisfactory contract, performance and payment bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of this contract constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The City is not legally bound until the contract

is duly executed by the City. The bid deposit may be retained if the bidder fails to execute the contract or give satisfactory surety as required by N.C.G.S. 143-129.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that RES Environmental Operating Company, LLC will be required to subcontract, at a minimum, 6.05% with minority-owned businesses and 12.14% with women-owned businesses as indicated on the Affidavit “C” submitted by the company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds have been appropriated in the FY 2025 budget to cover the cost of this contract.
