U.S. Army Reserves, and the Regular Army have contributed immensely

to health and natural disaster response; and

WHEREAS: Citizens of the City of Winston-Salem have proudly served and made the

ultimate sacrifice for our nation's freedom while serving in the United States

Army and other branches of our nation's military.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. ALLEN JOINES, Mayor of the City of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, do hereby proclaim Saturday, June 14, 2025 as

UNITED STATES ARMY'S 250th BIRTHDAY

and express appreciation to the United States Army and to the dedicated Soldiers who have served in it over the 250 years it has been in existence.
