**Summary of Information:**

In accordance with the City of Winston-Salem’s Traffic Calming Policy, approved by the City Council in 2003 and modified in 2016, representatives of Pennsylvania Avenue formed a Traffic Calming Task Force and submitted a petition for traffic calming. The traffic calming plan calls for two multi-way stops. The Pennsylvania Avenue residents have completed all the required steps outlined in the policy, therefore, the Department of Transportation recommends approval and construction of the plan at a cost of \$2,500.
