Summary of Information:

The City Code allows the City to ban thru vehicles over a certain registered weight when there are better street alternatives for those vehicles to use.

The Department of Transportation recommends that thru trucks with registered gross vehicle weight in excess of 13,000 pounds be prohibited on Polo Road between Cherry Street and Robinhood Road. (Attachment A)

The Department of Transportation also recommends that thru trucks with registered gross vehicle weight in excess of 13,000 pounds be prohibited on Carver School Road between New Walkertown Road and Old Walkertown Road. (Attachment B)
