Historic Resources staff has reviewed the seven properties that are scheduled to go before the Community Development/Housing/General Government Committee on November 9, 2021 for demolition consideration. Per the list provided by Community Development, the proposed demolitions are:

1. 1206 23rd Street – Burned
2. 1849 Kentucky Avenue
3. 1340 Bridgton Road
4. 526 Lockland Avenue - Burned

Local Historic Landmarks or Local Historic/Historic Overlay Districts

None of the buildings are Local Historic Landmarks or located within locally designated historic districts.

National Register Historic Districts

The house at 526 Lockland Avenue is in the Ardmore Historic District. However, the house has had a fire and requires demolition for the safety of the community. None of the other buildings are listed on the National Register of Historic Places individually or as part of a district.
