NCDOT also requests that the City of Winton-Salem adopt a concurring ordinance adopting Old Walkertown Road (SR 2456) from a point 0.037 miles east of Lane Street to the Winston-Salem municipal limit at a point 0.126 miles west of Plantation Road (SR 2222) as a 45 MPH roadway. Both Liberty Street and Old Walkertown Road are currently posted at 45 MPH. These concurring ordinances will consolidate and correct current ordinances.
