Terms of the bid allow the City to extend the contract for as many as two additional annual mowing periods, provided the City and Contractor agree and funds are made available for this purpose. If the Contract is extended, prices may be adjusted at the beginning of each additional (annual) period by an amount not to exceed the Consumer Price Index (CPI) as reported in the latest available Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U).

It is recommended that a contract for mowing services be awarded to Going Green Lawn Care LLC in the annual amount of \$42,880 with option to extend the contract for two additional years, giving the contract a total potential value of \$128,640. It is also recommended that a contract for mowing services be awarded to Riverhill Landscaping, Inc. in the annual amount of \$50,696 with option to extend for two additional years for a total potential value of \$152,088. It is further recommended that a contract for mowing services be awarded to Crawford Landscaping, Inc. in the annual amount of \$26,320 with option to extend for two additional years, for a total potential value of \$78,960.

The Vegetation Management FY 2021-22 operations budget includes sufficient funds to cover these contracts through June 30, 2022. Funding for the remainder of the 2022 mowing season as well as for any future extensions is subject to future budget appropriations.
