This special use permit is further issued pursuant to approval of the site plan entitled <u>Real Deal K-9 Training</u> and identified as Attachment "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein.

The site shall be developed in accordance with Attachment "A", provided the property is developed in accordance with requirements of the Zoning Ordinance of the *Unified Development Ordinances*, and other applicable laws, and the following additional conditions be met:

• PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE(S) OF OCCUPANCY:

a. Any outdoor enclosures must be surrounded by an opaque fence at least five (5) feet in height.

• OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

a. Any use of the outdoor enclosure by animals or pets must be supervised by a person or persons present within the outdoor enclosure. Animal waste must be managed daily as per applicable sanitation codes and ordinances.
