Resolution Awarding Purchase Order for Two 3/4 Ton Cargo Vans

## **Summary of Information:**

Property and Facilities Management is requesting to replace two cargo vans that are used to provide maintenance to all 378 facilities City-wide. Both existing vehicles are well past their useful life, have high mileage and excessive maintenance/repair costs. See Exhibit A for detailed replacement information.

Purchasing advertised a formal bid for the purchase of two ¾ ton cargo vans, and three bids meeting specifications were received on October 13, 2023, as follows:

It is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Piedmont Truck Center for the purchase of two Ford Transit cargo vans at a cost of \$50,903.00 each for a total amount of \$101,806.00.

The City's FY 2023-24 capital equipment budget includes sufficient funds for this purchase, which will be financed through the City's internal leasing program.
