| The MapForsyth Addressing Team was contacted by a citizen that lives on Rosewood Avenue and asked about the renaming of a disconnected segment of Rosewood Avenue. The citizen stated that delivery drivers regularly turn onto the disconnected segment of Rosewood Avenue and are unable to locate residences that are addressed off Rosewood Avenue. The disconnected segment is approximately 330 feet long and is located between Knollwood and Bellview Streets. The segment of Rosewood Avenue with the addressed homes is approximately 2700 feet long and has 71 addressed homes. The disconnected segment serves no addressed property. The two property owners to the south of the segment have been contacted and agree with the name change. Snyder Garden Avenue was suggested by one of the adjoining property owners. Miller Park is located to the North. Following a public hearing, staff recommends the Council adopt the attached ordinance approving this request. | | | | |
