

**ORDINANCE RENEWING THE CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE  
AND NECESSITY OF HERITAGE CARRIAGES FOR THE OPERATION OF FOUR  
HORSE DRAWN CARRIAGES IN THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem as follows:

Pursuant to Section 78-49 of the Winston-Salem City Code, the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem does hereby renew the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity of Heritage Carriages to operate four horse drawn carriages in the City of Winston-Salem. In granting the renewal, the Council finds the following:

The owner of Heritage Carriages has applied for a renewal of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the operation of four horse drawn carriages in the City of Winston-Salem. The certificate was originally issued on January 2, 1996 to Mr. Claude Stevenson (“Steve”) Allred and Mr. Samuel Allred, D.B.A. Heritage Carriages for four authorized carriages. There have been no other changes since January 20, 2015.

The passage of this ordinance constitutes a renewal of a franchise which is granted subject to the provisions of Chapter 78 of the Winston-Salem City Code and all other ordinances governing the operation of vehicles for hire in the City of Winston-Salem, and all applicable laws of the State of North Carolina, as same are now in effect or as may hereinafter be enacted or amended.

This franchise is not transferable except as provided by law.

The City Council reserves the right to revoke this franchise in its discretion.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that after this ordinance has been favorably voted upon at two meetings of the City Council, the Department of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to issue a renewal of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Mr. Claude Stevenson (“Steve”) Allred and Mr. Samuel Allred, D.B.A. Heritage Carriages.
