## **Summary of Information:**

The owner of City Cab has made an application for renewal and company name change for the operation of five taxicabs. The certificates were originally issued on April 4, 2011 to Mr. Gora Fall and Mr. Lamane Mboup D.B.A. City Cab. Mr. Gora Fall and Mr. Lamane Mboup are no longer in business together. However, Mr. Mboup continues to operate City Cab and has requested to change the name to Green Cab. The applicant has provided documentation showing his capabilities to meet the financial requirements and has no outstanding debt with the City.

Based on our review of the application from Mr. Mboup, it is recommended that this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be approved, pending the company's compliance with all City Codes, licenses, permits and zoning requirements.

If all the renewals are approved, the City will have 152 authorized limousines, 120 taxicabs services and 2 trolley pubs.
