## **Summary of Information:**

On February 18, 2018, the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem adopted an Ordinance to cause the dwelling located at 1509 E. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street to be demolished. This action was taken as a result of the owner's failure to comply with a duly issued Order to repair, vacate and close the dwelling which was unfit for human habitation as prescribed in the Housing Code of the City of Winston-Salem.

After the Ordinance was adopted, the Neighborhood Services Department demolished the property. A demolition assessment lien was placed on the property. The owner has paid off the demolition assessment lien and the property has been sold.

The new owner Dilek Real Estate LLC has requested that the City Council of the City of Winston Salem rescind the Ordinance adopted February 18, 2018, allowing the ordinance of record relating to said property to be cancelled.
