RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO SHARE CO-OP FOR HARVEST MARKET PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. 160A-456

WHEREAS, SHARE Co-op has approached the City with a request for financial

assistance in the amount of \$300,000 to support the opening of Harvest Market, a full-service

grocery store operating under the cooperative model with a focus on providing fresh foods at a

reasonable cost to families in and around areas designated as food deserts; and

WHEREAS, the Market will operate out of an 8,700 square foot tenant space in the West

Salem Shopping Center located at the intersection of Peters Creek and Academy Streets; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, the Mayor and City Council approved a request from SHARE to

fund a feasibility study and provide consulting services to evaluate the development of a

cooperative grocery store; and

WHEREAS, since that time, SHARE has embarked on an aggressive member recruitment

drive and fundraising campaign, attracting more than 400 member-owners and receiving financial

commitments totaling approximately \$1.49 million to-date The consultants enlisted to develop the

feasibility study identified an initial start-up cost of approximately \$2.4 million. To-date, SHARE

has attracted more than 400 member/owners and has received; and

WHEREAS, SHARE is seeking support from the City in the form of a grant; and

WHEREAS, the release of the City's funding for the project shall be conditioned on

SHARE demonstrating that all funding required to initiate the project have been secured.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of the
