

**RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER  
FOR DODGE CHARGER POLICE PURSUIT VEHICLES**

**WHEREAS**, after due advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by the City/County Purchasing Department at 12:00 p.m. on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of September 2016, for sixty three Dodge Charger police pursuit vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, did award a purchase order for the purchase of sixty three Dodge Charger police pursuit vehicles at \$24,078 each to Ginn Chrysler Jeep Dodge LLC in the total amount of \$1,516,914; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has needs for an additional twenty five Dodge Charger police pursuit vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, terms of the original bid allows the purchase of additional vehicles meeting the same specifications for 12 months following the bid award; and

**WHEREAS**, Ginn Chrysler Jeep Dodge LLC has offered these additional vehicles that meet all specifications, at a cost of \$24,078 each; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a purchase order be awarded to Ginn Chrysler Jeep Dodge LLC for the purchase of twenty five Dodge Charger police pursuit vehicles at \$24,078 for a total award of \$601,950.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, that a purchase order for the purchase of twenty five Dodge Charger police pursuit vehicles at \$24,078 each is hereby awarded to Ginn Chrysler Jeep Dodge LLC in the total amount of \$601,950.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the award of this purchase order constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualification of the bidder. The City is not legally bound to perform the purchase order until the purchase order is duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the purchase is included in the FY 2017-18 capital budget and will be financed through the North Carolina Municipal Leasing Corporation with funding for the lease payments available in the FY 2017-18 General Fund budget..

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City may reimburse itself for the capital expenditures identified herein with the proceeds from the sale of tax-exempt obligations.
