Approval of a Resolution Approving the Robinhood Road Traffic Calming Plan for Funding and Construction. (Northwest Ward)

**Summary of Information:**

In accordance with the City of Winston-Salem’s Traffic Calming Policy approved by the City Council in 2003 and modified in 2016, representatives of Robinhood Road between Reynolda Road and Stratford Road formed a traffic calming task force and submitted a petition for traffic calming. The traffic calming plan calls for narrowing of the travel lanes between Reynolda Road and Stratford Road with edgelines and the construction of a gateway island on Robinhood Road at Reynolda Road. The Robinhood Road residents have completed all the required steps outlined in the policy, therefore, the Department of Transportation recommends approval and construction of the plan at a cost of \$20,000. The plan is attached.
