## **Summary of Information:**

The City of Winston-Salem has received a petition from Thomas Sekits to close and abandon a portion of Helen Avenue. The area petitioned for closure is an unopened 30-foot platted right-of-way that extends southeast from Helen Avenue and is approximately 376 feet in length. It is bounded on north by Tax PIN's 6838-41-7535, 6838-41-6656, and 6838-41-6715 and on the south by Tax Pin's 6838-41-8327, 6838-41-6378, 6838-41-5552, and 6838-41-4663.

The Public Works Department has reviewed the request. There are no Planning concerns if this right-of-way is closed. WSDOT recommends not closing the right-of-way because closing the right-of-way will limit future developments' ability to create internal connectivity. There are overhead utility lines in this right-of-way so easements will need to be retained. Sanitation services will not be interrupted.
