Summary of Information:

The Traffic Maintenance Division of the Transportation Department needs to purchase two new one-ton pickup trucks as replacements for vehicles that have high mileage and excessive maintenance costs. This equipment is used primarily for the daily operations of the sign maintenance crew and is essential to normal operations. Additionally, sign maintenance crews use these trucks when scheduled for on-call duty. See Exhibit A for detailed replacement information.

Purchasing advertised a formal bid, and two bids for the purchase of two one-ton pickup trucks were received on August 18, 2023, as follows:

It is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Modern Chevrolet for the purchase of two 2024 Chevrolet 3500 crew cab pickups with utility bodies and traffic signs, per specifications, at a cost of \$112,523.00 each for a total cost of \$225,046.00.

The FY 2023-24 capital equipment budget includes sufficient funds for this purchase, which will be financed through the City's internal leasing program.
