**RESOLUTION REVISING EROSION CONTROL FEES SUBSEQUENT
TO THE ADOPTION OF HOUSE BILL 489**

WHEREAS, erosion control staff are responsible for the oversight and administration of grading and land disturbing activities for all areas within Forsyth County (except Kernersville, King, and High Point); and

WHEREAS, the City and County have adopted fees for the administration of said services;
and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly adopted House Bill 489 on August 30, 2021 which establishes fee requirements for local governments related to erosion control activities; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to revise its fee schedule for erosion control activities in order to comply with the provisions of HB 489; and

WHEREAS, staff has worked collaboratively with representatives from the Home Builders Association in developing a revised erosion control fee schedule; and

WHEREAS, the proposed fee structure may result in a slight reduction in collected revenues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon recommendation of the City Manager, that the revised erosion control fees be adopted as shown on Attachment 1 titled "Revised Erosion Control Fees," with an effective date of November 15, 2021.
