Resolution Authorizing a Subrecipient Agreement with Davidson County for Surface Transportation Block Grant – Direct Attributable Funding.

Summary of Information:

The City of Winston-Salem serves as the Lead Planning Agency (LPA) and manages the transportation planning funds and administration of the Surface Transportation Block Grant – Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) program for the Winston-Salem Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (WSUAMPO). On September 17, 2020, the WSUAMPO approved the allocation of \$111,768 to Davidson County Transportation System to install covered bus shelters with ADA access at major stop locations and to install Simme Seats at the remaining bus stops.

In January 2022, the Federal Highway Administration approved the Transfer of STBG-DA funds to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) as Section 5307 funds to be used by the transit agency for the aforementioned project.

The City serves as the pass-through agency for these funds requiring an intergovernmental agreement with Davidson County. Approval of this item will authorize the City Manager of Winston-Salem to enter into an agreement for the suballocation to Davidson County. On March 27, 2023, the Davidson County Board of Commissioners also approved entering into this agreement.
