RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A TEMPORARY INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES IN PREPARATION FOR, DURING, AND AFTER THE 2020 REPUBLICAN NATIONAL CONVENTION

WHEREAS, The City of Charlotte, North Carolina has been designated as the host city for the 2020 Republican National Convention (the "RNC") scheduled to be held on August 24-27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, The City of Charlotte requires additional law enforcement personnel to assist in providing various law enforcement services in connection with the RNC for the period August 22-28, 2020; and

WHEREAS, The Winston-Salem Police Department ("WSPD") has agreed to provide such assistance by assigning 100 WSPD officers to perform law enforcement services under a Temporary Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Winston-Salem and the City of Charlotte (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte will pay the salaries and transportation costs for all assigned WSPD personnel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem reserves the right under the Agreement to recall some or all assigned officers based upon the public safety needs of the City of Winston-Salem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Winston-Salem City

Council, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a "Temporary

Intergovernmental Agreement for Law Enforcement Services in Preparation for, During, and

After the 2020 Republican National Convention."
