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**RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER FOR
CONVENTIONAL DAY CAB WITH HOOK LIFT HOIST BODY**

WHEREAS, Vegetation Management has budgeted to purchase a conventional day cab with hook lift hoist body as a replacement for equipment that meets Fleet’s replacement criteria; and

WHEREAS, five bids for the purchase of a day cab with hoist body meeting bid specifications were received on October 25, 2023, as follows:

WHEREAS, it is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Lilley International for the purchase of an International MV chassis with Swaploader hook lift body in the total amount of \$176,495.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, upon approval by the Finance Committee, that a purchase order is hereby awarded to Lilley International for the purchase of an International MV chassis with Swaploader hook lift body in the total amount of \$176,495.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that award of this purchase order constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidder. The company’s offer, the bid specifications, and the City's purchase order will constitute the contract. The City is not legally bound until the purchase order is duly executed by the City.
