Summary of Information:

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 funds are apportioned to urban areas with more than 200,000 in population and are used for operating and capital assistance. The Winston-Salem Urbanized Area received an appropriation of FTA Section 5307 funding in the amount of \$4,950,845 for FY 2019 and \$5,386,052 for FY 2020. The City of Winston-Salem is the designated recipient of this funding for the Winston-Salem Urbanized Area.

The Winston-Salem Urban Area Transportation Advisory Committee approved the FY 2019 and FY 2020 apportionments to the three eligible sub-recipients and Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) agencies for funding. Davidson County Transportation was approved for \$217,793 in FY 2019 and \$352,685 in FY 2020. Davidson County Transportation will serve as a sub-recipient to the City of Winston-Salem for these funds.
