Summary of Information:			
Bids were scheduled to be received April 12, 2017, for the Lockland Avenue Park drainage improvements project. The scope of work includes the removal of the existing drainage system and new construction of approximately 700 LF of drainage pipe. North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) 143-132(a) requires a minimum of three bids for formal construction and repair contracts; however fewer than three bids were offered. Therefore, as authorized by N.C.G.S. 143-129, the project was re-advertised and bids were then opened on April 21, 2017, with only one bid received as follows:
