### Council Action Requested:

- A. Resolution Authorizing an Agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the Replacement of the Old Greensboro Road Bridge over Brushy Fork Creek (HM-0004) (East Ward).
- B. Project Budget Ordinance Amendment to Appropriate \$4,815,000 from the Bridge Formula Program (BFP)

### Summary of Information:

The Bridge Formula Program (BFP) is a program that provides funding to the states through the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) to replace, rehabilitate, preserve, protect, and construct highway bridges. The program funding can be used on bridges located on or off the Federal-aid system. The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) and City of Winston-Salem have identified Bridge 330330 over Brushy Fork Creek as an off-system bridge owned by a county, town, township, city, municipality, or other local agency eligible for 100 percent Federal reimbursement through the Bridge Formula Program. This project was selected as a complete bridge replacement with construction programmed for 2028 at an estimated cost of \$4,815,000.

If approved, the NCDOT Agreement would authorize funds for preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition, and construction related services for the replacement of the bridge. A summary of the funded activities are as follows:
