ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS A LOCAL HISTORIC LANDMARK

WHEREAS, all of the prerequisites to the adoption of this ordinance as prescribed by Chapter 160D, Article 9, Part 4 of the North Carolina General Statutes have been met; and

WHEREAS, the Forsyth County Historic Resources Commission has submitted a designation application and report, which is incorporated herein by reference, and does not recommend after a public hearing that the property described below be designated a local historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, the City of Winston-Salem after a separate public hearing finds that the property described herein is of historical, architectural, and/or cultural significance, and the property's preservation should be encouraged, and that the qualifying elements exist as set forth in the designation application/report:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Winston-Salem City Council as follows:

- Section 1. The following described property is hereby designated a local historic landmark: Shipley Building, 609 North Liberty Street, specifically: the complete exterior and interior of the Shipley Building; for the avoidance of doubt, grounds, excess land, and other buildings on the tax parcel are not designated as being a historic landmark; which sits on a portion of PIN 6835-28-2206 that is highlighted on the attached map, which is part of Tax Block 0013, Tax Lot 220. This property is owned by Fain Properties LLC.
- **Section 2.** The review process provided by law shall be observed prior to demolition, alteration, rehabilitation, or removal of the designated property.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its adoption.
