**ORDINANCE RENEWING THE CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND
NECESSITY OF GREEN CAB (FORMERLY CITY CAB) FOR THE OPERATION OF
FIVE TAXICABS IN THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem as follows:

Pursuant to Section 78-49 of the Winston-Salem City Code, the City Council of the City of Winston-Salem does hereby renew the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity of Green Cab (formerly City Cab) to operate five taxicabs in the City of Winston-Salem. In granting the renewal, the Council finds the following:

The owner of Green Cab has applied for a renewal of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the operation of five taxicabs. The certificates were originally issued on April 4, 2011 to Mr. Gora Fall and Mr. Lamane Mboup D.B.A. City Cab. Mr. Gora Fall and Mr. Lamane Mboup are no longer in business together. However, Mr. Mboup continues to operate City Cab. Mr. Mboup has requested his authorized vehicles under certificate to be transferred to Green Cab and decreased from six to five. There have been no other changes since January 22, 2019.

The passage of this ordinance constitutes a renewal of a franchise which is granted subject to the provisions of Chapter 78 of the Winston-Salem City Code and all other ordinances governing the operation of vehicles for hire in the City of Winston-Salem, and all applicable laws of the State of North Carolina, as same are now in effect or as may hereinafter be enacted or amended.

This franchise is not transferable except as provided by law.

The City Council reserves the right to revoke this franchise in its discretion.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that after this ordinance has been favorably voted upon at two meetings of the City Council, the Department of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to issue a renewal of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Mr. Lamane Mboup D.B.A Green Cab.
