On August 23, 2021 in a Special Meeting of the City Council, City staff presented a framework for spending the City's \$51.7 million allocation of CLFRF. City staff recommended a phased approach for spending the funds. Under this approach, the City would provide immediate relief to the local economy through a grant program and provide more transformative, outcome-based programs in future phases. The guiding principles for spending of funds include process transparency, economic restoration, community transformation, fiscal soundness, and equitable outcomes.	
This item offers information on both phases of the CLFRF framework. Regarding the immediate relief phase, this item presents a general overview of marketing efforts that will be undertaken to ensure that news and information regarding the City's Recovery Grants Program for Small Businesses and Non-Profits are widely shared (see Exhibit 1). Regarding the transformational phase, this item presents an update to the Transformational Scoring Matrix (originally presented as an information item on November 9, 2021), which reflects an addition of an outcomes-based approach to the poverty reduction component in Tier 2 of the Strategic Plan alignment scoring. In addition to the matrix, this item offers a potential request for proposals process for the transformational phase.
