


The Forsyth County DRIVE program provides an avenue through which Forsyth County residents burdened by economic hardship may engage with the court system to have their drivers license restored.

CYCLE OF REVOCATION



Eligibility

 You may be eligible for assistance through the DRIVE Program if the **Department of Motor vehicles** suspended your driver's license prior to 2015 for failing to pay court costs and fines after receiving a traffic citation in Forsyth County.

Partnership

In February 2020, City Council Appropriated \$275,000 to Assist with the Expansion of the Program:

- Operating Expenses
- Legal Assistant
- Assistant District Attorney
- Administrative Clerk

Program Success

- \$83,683 fees waived on 587 criminal charges
- Relief to 127 residents
- 373 pending applications
- Average of 10 applications a day

Program Challenges

- Job Posting Requirements
- Courthouse Closures from the COVID 19 Pandemic
- Keeping the ADA position filled (most candidates want to prosecute, and prosecution is NOT a part of the DRIVE Program)

Remaining Funding

- \$154,025.78 and Yearly Projected Expenses are \$179, 605.42
- Request for the Mayor and City Council to Authorize a 10-Month Contract Extension
