

## W-2936 920 Brookstown Neighborhood Outreach Report

On February 17, 2022, 457 outreach letters were sent to property owners and neighbors within 500 feet of the subject site and beyond. These letters provided a summary of the proposed final development plan request, as well as an illustrative site plan. In each letter Stimmel also provided contact information (phone and email) in the event any of the neighbors had any questions or concerns about the proposed plan.

Five adjacent neighbors reached out regarding the proposed plan.

- 1) Business owner on Burke Street.
  - a) The representative had no issues with the proposed project and was supportive.
- 2) Business owner on Burke Street
  - a) No concerns expressed
- 3) Business owner with property on Spring Street
  - a) The representative had no issues with the proposed project and was supportive.
- 4) Adjacent property owner of 131 Fayette Street
  - a) Requested contact information for developer, which was provided. Discussed concern regarding stormwater run-off based on existing drainage pipes on property. Property owner questioned whether there was interest in purchasing their property.
- 5) Jason Thiel with Downtown Winston-Salem Partnership
  - a) Supportive of project.

### Regarding:

A multi-family apartment project of approximately 279 units is being proposed as a part of the overall Ball Park development plan. The proposed project is located on approximately 4.15 acres and bounded by First Street, Second Street, Fayette Street, and Brookstown Ave. Multi-family residential is allowed by right per the existing zoning and requires a Final Development Plan to be reviewed by the Planning Board and approved by the City Council.

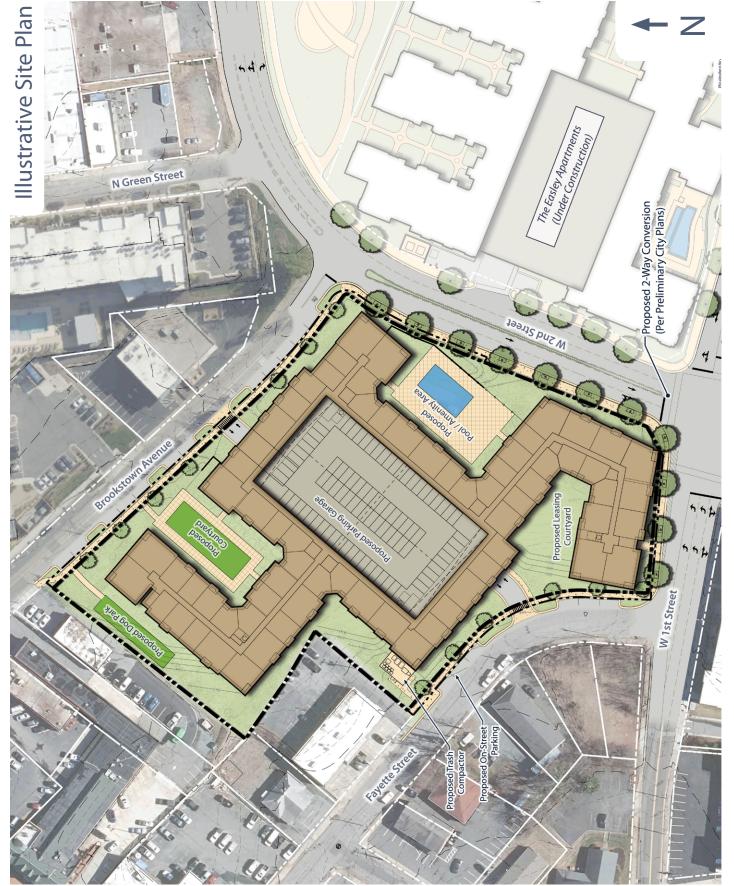
