## **Summary of Information:**

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) and the City of Winston-Salem entered into an agreement dated June 27, 2016, related to the betterments and associated cost sharing for certain elements of the Business 40 project. Throughout the project, the parties have agreed to supplement the original agreement.

The City Council voted on November 2016 to formalize the maintenance responsibilities for certain elements related to the Business 40 improvement such as Sidewalks, the Multi-Use Path, lighting, the Green Street Bridge, the Strollway Bridge and any other aesthetic betterments.

This third amendment formalizes the maintenance responsibility for the landscaping by the City to begin two years after completion of plantings. The landscaping is to be designed and installed by NCDOT without any additional cost to the city.
