## **Summary of Information:**

The Winston-Salem Fleet Services Department and Fire Department has regular needs to purchase auto and truck tires. After receiving bids, the State of North Carolina awarded term contract 863A and Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, Parrish Tire Company, Inc., and Snider Tire Company dba Snider Fleet Solutions (all Winston-Salem businesses) were selected as authorized to provide vehicle tires at state contract pricing.

It is recommended to award purchase orders for auto and truck tires from the period of July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, to Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company in the estimated amount of \$210,000, Parrish Tire Company, Inc. in the estimated amount of \$310,000 and Snider Tire Company dba Snider Fleet Solutions in the estimated amount of \$230,000, under and in accordance with the North Carolina State Contract.

This recommendation is in accordance with N.C.G.S 143-129(e)(9): "The [bidding] requirements of this article do not apply to purchases from contracts established by the State or any agency of the State, if the contractor is willing to extend to a political subdivision of the State the same or more favorable prices, terms, or conditions as established in the State contract."

M/WBE comment: Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, Parrish Tire Company, Inc., and Snider Tire Company dba Snider Fleet Solutions were selected by the State of North Carolina as approved dealers for these tire purchases.
