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# RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE EXECUTION OF THE AMENDMENT TO THE SECOND AMENDED AND RESTATED PARKING LEASE, MEMORANDUM, AND ASSIGNMENT OF THE LEASE FOR 932 BROOKSTOWN AVENUE 

WHEREAS, Brookstown Development Partners, LLC ("BDP") has sold, for the construction of apartments units, several lots used for baseball parking; and

WHEREAS, the Second Amended and Restated Parking Lease ("Parking Lease") and the Assignment thereof, executed in 2014, gives BDP the right to substitute/provide replacement parking spaces when parking spaces are eliminated, provided there is at least a one-for-one replacement, which, based upon a parking lease between BDP and Carolina University, has occurred; and

WHEREAS, BDP and Carolina University have agreed to reevaluate their parking agreement in two years, which may necessitate another substitution/replacement of parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, because the Parking Lease identifies, as parking spaces, the $\operatorname{lot}(\mathrm{s})$ where BDP intends to build apartments, the title company required the removal of said land from the Parking Lease; and

WHEREAS, because of language in the Parking Lease that automatically grants that authority to BDP, staff signed the Amendment to Parking Lease and Memorandum thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City leases 932 Brookstown Avenue for the Police Department's Fleet Operation from BDP, which BDP has sold; and

WHEREAS, the current lease will terminate at the end of the year; and

WHEREAS, at closing, BDP had to assign the lease to the new buyer, which assignment was also executed by City staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem do hereby ratify the execution of the Amendment to the Second Amended and Restated Parking Lease, the Memorandum, and the Assignment of the lease for 932 Brookstown Avenue.
