

- Total Annual BudgetIncrease of \$95.3 million
- Compensation Includes:
  - 34 net new positions
    - I4 for Recycling transition
  - New Public Safety Pay Plans
- Capital Projects Includes:
  - \$55 million in LOBs






## BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS: PROPERTY TAX RATE

- Property tax rate increase of 2.36 cents (proposed rate: 63.6 cents per \$100 of assessed value)
  - I.5 cents related to personnel increase, supporting new public safety pay plans
  - 0.86 cents for increases in recycling program
  - Less regressive form of revenue compared to a user fee
