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RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH FORWARD THINKING SYSTEMS FOR AUTOMATED VEHICLE LOCATION SERVICES

WHEREAS, in March 2018 the Mayor and City Council approved a contract with Verizon for the current Automated Vehicle Location (AVL) global positioning system and cellular air services; and

WHEREAS, the AVL services have been utilized to track the location and status of vehicles, realize fuel savings, increase security, and improve employee safety and productivity; and

WHEREAS, the Verizon AVL services provide trend analysis reporting and tools to manage activities such as swapping devices between vehicles, registering new vehicles, removing vehicles from the fleet, and troubleshooting; and

WHEREAS, the 3G network that these Verizon services utilize will be sunset by December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City published a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking qualified vendors to provide a solution to the City's AVL needs covering approximately 1,376 vehicles; and

WHEREAS, The City received four responses to the RFP from qualified vendors including one M/WBE vendor; and

WHEREAS, the City completed an evaluation process including in-person presentations by each of the four vendors highlighting their proposed solution; and

WHEREAS, the evaluation team recommends Forward Thinking Systems be selected as the vendor to provide the City's AVL solution; and

WHEREAS, approval is requested that the City enter into a five-year contract with Forward Thinking Systems in the amount of \$234,000 per year and a five-year total cost of \$1,170,000, with funding for the first year of these services available in the FY 22-23 operating budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into a five-year contract with Forward Thinking Systems for AVL services for the cost of \$234,000 per year, with a five-year cost of \$1,170,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the City.
