## **Summary of Information:**

The Winston-Salem Department of Transportation received a request from Highland Presbyterian Church to install a Rectangular Rapid-Flashing Beacon (RRFB) at the existing crosswalk near the church at 2380 Cloverdale Avenue. The Church has requested the installation of the RRFB to further improve the visibility of pedestrians in the crosswalk and promote driver compliance with yield-to-pedestrian laws.

Historically, private organizations making a request for RRFBs have contributed to the cost to purchase the equipment, while Traffic Field Operations (TFO) has managed the installation and maintenance of the equipment. Existing RRFBs on Cloverdale Avenue, Northwest Boulevard and Reynolda Road were all installed under a similar arrangement in which the organization requesting the device contributed to the cost. This item is to request approval for the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Highland Presbyterian Church for the acceptance of funds in the amount of \$10,000, which is the estimated cost of the RRFB equipment.
