Summary of Information:

The Property & Facilities Maintenance Department has a need for a contractor who will provide routine pest control services at various facilities throughout the City, including facilities that are currently or will be under construction and/or renovation.

City/County Purchasing issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) to provide routine pest control services and on June 17, 2022 one proposal was received from Triad Pest Control, Inc. of Winston-Salem N.C.

Terms of the bid document specified detailed evaluation criteria of M/WBE commitment, business location, cost and references. An evaluation panel of staff members from Property & Facilities Maintenance, Operations, Sanitation, and Business Inclusion and Advancement reviewed the proposal received. See Exhibit A for the detailed scores.

Based upon the evaluation panel's assessment, it is recommended that a contract for routine pest control services per the prices offered in the RFP be awarded to Triad Pest Control, Inc., in the annual amount of \$33,408. Terms of the bid allow for the possibility of two annual extensions, giving the contract a total potential value of \$100,224.
