Resolution Awarding Purchase Order for Pumper Fire Truck

Summary of Information:

Winston-Salem Fire Department has the need to purchase a pumper fire truck for Unit 22 as a replacement for the current 2008 Sutphen HS-4424 pumper truck, with over 150,000 miles, original purchase price of \$390,997.50 and \$121,939.79 in accrued repair and maintenance costs over its life.

The Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC), a competitive bidding group purchasing program, received bids for fire service apparatus and on October 25, 2019, Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc., located in Manassas, Virginia was awarded competitive bid contract #FS12-19 product code FS19V07 specifications for the pumper fire truck and offers the Pierce Enforcer pumper fire truck per HGAC specifications, including the performance bond, at a cost of \$846,171.00.

N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3) authorizes "purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing products and services at discount prices to two or more public agencies."

It is recommended that a purchase order be awarded to Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc. for the purchase of one pumper fire truck per bid contract #FS12-19 product code FS19V07 specifications for the total award amount of \$846,171.00. This recommendation is in accordance with N.C.G.S. 143-129(e)(3).

The acquisition cost of the apparatus is \$93,811 more than originally budgeted; however, the City's FY 2022-23 capital equipment budget includes sufficient funds for this purchase which will be financed through the City's internal leasing program with funding for the lease payments available in the General Fund FY 2022-23 budget.
