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**RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE ORDER  
FOR HALF-TON PICKUP TRUCKS**

**WHEREAS**, the Fleet Services division of the Property and Facilities Maintenance Department has the need to purchase new half-ton pickup trucks as replacements for current vehicles that meet or exceed fleet replacement criteria; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were received on October 7, 2022, for the purchase of 56 half-ton pickup trucks and the following bids were received:

**WHEREAS**, following receipt of bids, a decision was made to reduce the amount of gas-powered vehicles purchased in order to reserve funds for the purchase of hybrid and/or electric vehicles in the Spring of 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Finance Committee that a purchase order be awarded to Performance Chrysler Dodge Jeep Ram of Clinton, NC for the purchase of 28 half-ton pickup trucks that meet specifications required by the City in the amount of \$30,156 each for a total cost of \$844,368; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Winston-Salem, that a purchase order is hereby awarded to Performance Chrysler Dodge Jeep Ram for the purchase of 28 Ram 1500 Tradesman pickups per specifications at a cost of \$30,156 each for a total cost of \$844,368, the company's offer, and the City's purchase order will constitute the contract.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that award of this purchase order constitutes a preliminary determination as to the qualifications of the bidders. The City is not legally bound to perform the purchase order until the purchase order is duly executed by the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this purchase is included in the FY 2022-23 capital budget and will be financed through the City's internal leasing program with funding for the lease payments available in the FY 2022-23 General Fund budget.
