Summary of Information:

Expanding on the use of public safety security cameras is an Information Systems FY22-23 Key Work Item. Installation of security cameras is scheduled for numerous facilities throughout the City, including 18 Recreation sites, the Hydroponics Facility, Hanes Mill Landfill, and City Yard. Prior to the installation of security cameras, end-of-life network equipment at these facilities must be replaced.

Using specifications provided by Information Systems staff, the Purchasing Department advertised an Invitation for Bid for the network equipment. Responses were received from seven vendors, with the lowest quote provided by NWN Corporation.
